



LODGE 1 (WOODS)

This **Lodge** is the first of our big cabins. It is set overlooking a great pond area. You will understand how it got its name when you first walk in. This cabin is very open with a 25ft ceiling, large fully equipped kitchen and family room. It has two bathrooms and three bedrooms. It also has a great loft area with full and half bunk beds next to a great king size bed. There is a log burning fireplace, Satellite TV w/ a DVD player, air conditioning and room heat. The basement offers a nice sitting room, pool table and bar area. You will also find a 6 person hot tub on the lower patio area, a bonfire pit area and water frontage with a dock for throw back fishing. The Lodge is also surrounded by a 60 foot covered deck for outdoor eating and sitting. The Lodge can accommodate between 12 and 14 adults and children.

Check In & Check Out

Check in is at 3:00 p.m. and check out is at 11 a.m. If you would like an early arrival, please let us know ahead of time and we will do our best to accommodate you and your guests. You are expected to do a quick clean up throughout the used areas of the cabin. Please wash the dishes, place trash in the proper area and lock the cabin securely before departing. There is a broom and cleaning products located in the closet in the kitchen by the back door. There will be an additional charge for guests checking out after 11am.

Occupancy, Clean up and House keeping

Be sure to abide by the limit occupancy for each cabin. There will be an additional \$15 per guest fee. We also ask that you adhere to the pet and smoking policies. In the event of any damages or additional cleaning that we may endure there will be an additional charge. We will provide bed sheets, kitchenware and utensils. There is a \$25 charge for unwashed dishes. Please bring your own sleeping bags for bunkbeds and extra towels. We do provide dish soap, toilet paper and trash bags.

Amenities

Key: You will find the key that opens the side door located next to the mailbox on the right side of the door underneath the roof overhang. You will need to unlock the lock by matching the numbers (**included with your invoice packet**) across the etch mark. Hold down the black lever on front of the lock and pull from the bottom at the same time.

Key Return: Place the key back in the lock located just outside on the right hand side of the side door with the overhang patio. Put the lock in and mix up the numbers.

Kitchen: Includes bowls, cups, pots, pans, everyday cookware and all utensiles up to 12 settings. Also electric stove, microwave, dishwasher, refrigerator (ice trays; no ice maker), coffee maker, toaster, blender, wine opener. We encourage you to bring additional kitchenware for large parties.

TV: When you turn on the TV it should come right on Line AV1. If it does come up as A1 use the black remote and push the input button and a screen with options A1 and A2 will appear. Push A1 and push the select button and it will return. You must control the Volume with the black remote and the receiver. You must turn the channels with the Silver remote. The silver remote is the main remote. It offers a guide that will walk you through all the channels.

DVD: If you want to watch a movie, simply hit the input button on the black remote, choose A2 and push play on the DVD.

Fuse Box: If you should pop a breaker please call 330-327-5439.

Heater: The room temperature is set at 60, if you need to change the temperature push the up and down arrows to desired temp. There are floor heaters in all the bedrooms and basement. Please be sure to unplug when departing. The basement heater can be left alone and keep on 65 degrees before you leave.

Air Conditioner: The air conditioner is located under the window in the main area of the middle floor. Adjust the arrows up and down to control the temperature. You will find that it keeps the Cabin very comfortable at 73 in the summer time.

Log Burner: For easy lighting, we recommend bringing Duraflames logs with you. If you keep the flute open wide it will help in lighting the fire. Once the fire is going shut the flute halfway, shut the door and it will burn nicely for hours. Fill it up before bed and it will burn for 6 hours. Keep the ceiling fans on to keep the heat from rising and off it gets to warm in the family room.

Toiletries: All cabins are supplied with toilet paper and paper towels.

Towels: You will find 8 shower towels and 2 kitchen towels located inside the cabin.

Sheets: All 3 beds include linens, pillows and comforters. When you leave please give the place a quick clean and pull the sheets from the room you have slept in. Please place on top of the bed.

Bunkbeds: No linens or comforters provided. Please bring your own bedding.

Gas Grill: Provided for use during your stay. Please make sure to turn off gas after each use. Use at your own risk.

Hot Tub: The tub is set at 100. Prior to leaving please put in 1 cap of each chemical that has been left by the basement patio door and put the tub back to 100.

Firewood: There will be firewood left downstairs on the patio if you paid for it.

Trash Disposal: There is a trash barrel at the very front gate at the archway. Please put all your trash in the barrel when you leave and be sure the lids are on. Please do not leave any trash outside the barrel. You must take any additional trash with you.
